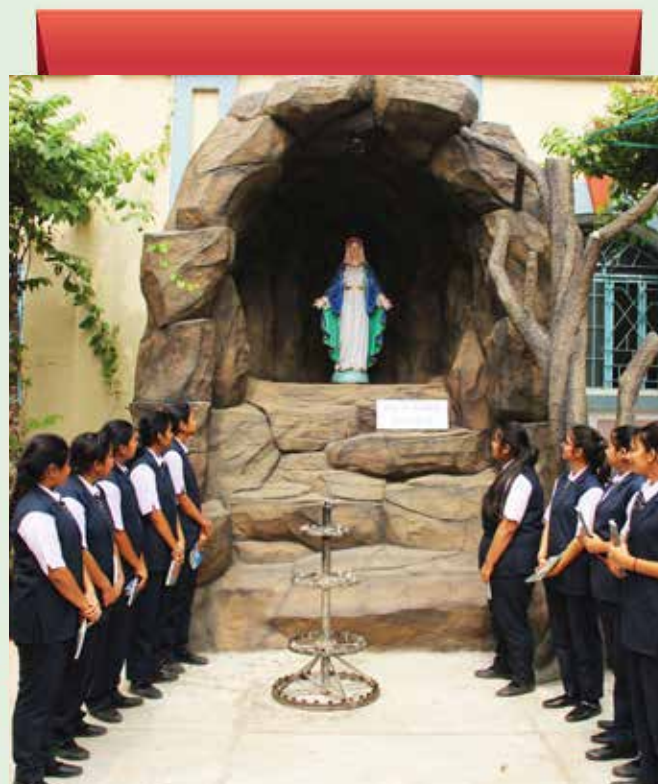


## Prospectus

St. Francis School, B. Deoghar, is an English Medium Co-educational school, conducted by the Franciscan Fathers and Brothers who are members of the Third Order Regular (T.O.R) of St. Francis of Assisi, after whom the school is named. It is governed by the Franciscan society which is a Religious and Charitable Organization registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

The T.O.R. Franciscans run several schools in India and abroad in which young people belonging to every creed, social class, community & linguistic group are educated through the medium of English and the regional languages. These efforts, while particularly responsible to the Christian community, have always been at the service of the whole nation. Thus, in these institutions, recognized as Christian Minority Institutions, the primary purpose is to educate Christian children, however, admission to school is open to all. The religious beliefs of all students are treated with respect.

Established on 10th January, 1970, the school has grown to be the Premier Institution. It is staffed by dedicated, competent and highly qualified Fathers, Sisters, and Teachers who create and foster the ethos for the all round growth and progress of the students. Franciscan Clarist Sisters are part of this journey.

The school was permanently affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (C.I.S.C.E.) Board in 1977 and was upgraded to the Indian School Certificate (I.S.C) or Plus Two, Delhi in 2004. ## Objective

The students are prepared for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (I.C.S.E), New Delhi, which has been recognized by the Government of India as one of the main All India School Education Boards. Since 2004 the school has been upgraded to Indian School Certificate (I.S.C. Or Plus Two), Delhi, having science and commerce streams. Besides St. Francis' students who have an unblemished record of character and fulfill the conditions set by the school, a few students from the other schools who are eligible will also, be considered for the admission to Plus Two.





## Curriculum

The medium of instruction is English but very special emphasis is given to Hindi, the national language, together with the essential subjects :- Sanskrit, History, Geography, Social studies, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Training, Computer Application, Commercial Application, Economics, Fine Arts etc. Keeping in mind, the unpardonable destruction being perpetrated on nature and ecology, Environmental Science has been included in the course of study. The School has well-equipped laboratories

for science, a modern computer lab and a rich library to allow the pupils to develop and foster their innate talents and keep abreast with the modern education from the very beginning.

The school lays a great deal of stress on character formation and development of spiritual and ethical values which are imparted regularly to students through the teaching of Moral Science. The Social Service League (S.S.L.), actively encourages students to help generating the spirit of "Service to Humankind" and enhance the love for Socially Useful and Productive Work.

## Clubs & Hobbies

Human resource development has been an integral part of the school curriculum. Various platforms are set up for the pupils to develop the latent potentialities so as to make a way for their creativity to shape through various clubs such as Nature Club, Music Club, Interactive Club, Sports Club, Rhetoric Club, Science Club etc.

## Admission

1. A valid and untampered Transfer Certificate from the school last attended shall be presented at the time of admission to class I and above.
2. All students must produce proper Birth Certificate. A valid Birth Certificate from the Municipality/Panchayath is to be submitted at the time of admission to Nursery.

3. A new candidate must be introduced personally to the Principal by his/her parents who will be responsible for his/her conduct and fees.
4. Boys and girls admitted to Nursery should be minimum three years and nine months old in March. An interaction of the parents together with child is required prior to admission.
5. Guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy. No subsequent change will be permitted thereafter for any reason whatsoever.



## Fees

1. Fees is collected by online payment only.
2. Parents will kindly save the receipts issued to them for counterchecking by the school office.
3. The school reserves its rights to revise the fees without prior notice.
4. The fee defaulters may be debarred from examinations and are liable to have their names struck off the rolls.

## Recommendations To The Parents
